



# Greek Project Rubric



**Objective:** You will create a visual representation of some part of Greek mythology we have discussed. You make create something about a specific god/goddess, or you can create something to represent one of the stories we have discussed. You may also create something from Greek mythology we have not discussed, but you must get my permission first. You must create something visual that describes either your god/goddess or a story. You might choose to create a poster, a mobile, a diorama, a sculpture, a paper-mache representation, a short play (with props and costumes), or a drawing. If you have another idea, come and clear it with me.

Your project will be worth 100 total points, and will be counted as a major grade worth 50%.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Representation of subject:** Detailed descriptions and visually informative (50 points)

\_\_\_\_\_ **Creativity:** Creative use of colors and products, showing time **and** effort expended (50 points)

Full points will be awarded for those projects which show comprehensive time and effort, and are ready for presentation. Projects which have that “done at the last minute” look will not receive full points, neither will those which show little time or effort involved in creating them.
